Cup Competitions- Rules

1. All relevant League Rules appertaining to Qualifications of Players & Conditions of Play are applicable to Cup Matches.
2. All relevant League Rules appertaining to the postponement of matches are applicable to Cup Matches, save that where a team is unable to raise a side, no points will be deducted but the opponent will be awarded the tie.
3. All relevant League Rules appertaining to the recording and reporting of results of matches are applicable to Cup Matches.
4. All relevant League Rules appertaining to the powers of the Management Committee are applicable to Cup Matches.
5. All matches will be played on a knockout basis, with each round being drawn separately. The team being drawn first will be declared the home team. The team drawn second shall be called the away team.
6. All relevant League Rules appertaining to club colours are applicable to Cup Matches.
7. All matches shall be played in accordance with The Laws of the Game as determined by the International Football Association Board, or for mini-soccer and 9-a-side football, the Laws as set down by the FA.
8. Each Round will be drawn at either a League Meeting, a Management Committee meeting, or at any other time as necessary provided at least two Officers of the League are present.
9. In cup competitions below Under 10s, the length of the match to be 20 minutes each way. If the scores are level, extra time of 2 minutes each way to be played. If the scores are still level, kicks to be taken from the penalty mark in accordance with The Laws of the Game.
10. In the Under 11 Cup Competition, the length of the match to be 25 minutes each way. If the scores are level, extra time of 5 minutes each way to be played. If the scores are still level, kicks to be taken from the penalty mark in accordance with The Laws of the Game.
11. In the Under 12 Cup Competition, the length of the match to be 30 minutes each way. If the scores are level, extra time of 10 minutes each way to be played. If the scores are still level, kicks to be taken from the penalty mark in accordance with The Laws of the Game.
12. In the Under 13 and 14 Cup Competition, the length of the match to be 35 minutes each way. If the scores are level, extra time of 10 minutes each way to be played. If the scores are still level, kicks to be taken from the penalty mark in accordance with The Laws of the Game.
13. In the Under 15 and 16 Cup Competition, the length of the match to be 40 minutes each way. If the scores are level, extra time of 10 minutes each way to be played. If the scores are still level, kicks to be taken from the penalty mark in accordance with The Laws of the Game.
14. ALL MATCHES MUST BE PLAYED TO A CONCLUSION AT THE FIRST TIME OF ASKING!
15. There is NO golden or silver goal in Extra Time.
16. Penalty kicks will be taken in strict adherence to The Laws of the Game for that season.
